IWS

Used to authorize work activities considered a high risk level , life critical or when two or more companies are performing work together on the same project.

Provides a foundation for a more precise and user friendly set of instructions that clearly identifies the hazards workers are not use to working with or may not be expecting during the performance of their work.



IWS

Major Topics Addressed

- Scope of Work
- Work period (start and completion dates)
- Work locations
- Management chain responsible for the work activity
- Specific hazards and necessary controls to safeguard workers
- Maintenance and Inspection requirements
- Emergency Response Plans and Procedures
- Worker specific training requirements
- Attached/referenced documents supplementing the IWS
- Authorizing Signatures

Benefits of IWS

- Reduced incidents
- Stream line communication
- Optimize performance (Front page of IWS)
- IWS binders for nested and reoccurring sites
