

## Purpose-Employee Qualification

During the New Hire Orientation, the employee receives craft specific training and test(s) in addition to their required safety council courses. The employee qualification card, helps the supervisor to identify who has been trained. This helps ensure quickly that all employees are up to date on needed trainings to safely perform the job tasks.

## Execution and Implementation-Employee Qualification Cards

- Issued during onboarding process from Safety Representative.
- Supervisors & Employees are trained on the Policy annually.
- Required to be on each employee at all job sites at all times and reviewed during pre-job meetings, safety meetings, and more.
- Continuously reviewed/audited and updated by Safety, Supervisors and Employees to maintain usage of Policy.





### Benefits and Results-Employee Qualification Cards

- Oualification Cards

  Employees able to know where all individual trainings are in one place on their person at all times-no electronics needed
  - Supervisors able to check crews to ensure all are trained and up to date on training to safely perform tasks
  - Owner benefits
    - Safer jobsite, to be used in addition to safety council, site requirements, etc.
    - Decreases potential for downtime sending crews with outdated/incorrect training(s)
    - Employee/Managers/Owners benefit from having all information in one place
    - Extremely beneficial for E-jobs & TARs/Outages-fast moving projects
    - Shows additional internal trainings by KCG





## Examples-Employee Qualification Cards

Scenario contractor does not have qualification cards

Owner calls at 3AM with a critical emergency, in the middle of outage season. There is an urgent need for a welding crew in a confined space to make a repair. This a new account that not all crews are familiar with and only 4 employees answer the phone who are able to work, but have never worked on this site, Client agrees to wave site required safety council to complete job. Contractor contact (very thorough and reliable) who took the call has personal issues unknown to Management and sends crews without verifying trainings in system. Crews arrive onsite to perform work, Supervisors assumed trainings are up to date (missed communication due to minimal management involvement & trusting but not verifying, late night, etc. Employees have safety meeting, all claim to be competent and UTD on CF training, site safety approves moving forward, breathing air onsite provided by client, and welders begin......
