


WJTA STANDARDIZED TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION



- Communication is key to safety, and training provides the foundation to communicate. Success within a project or turnaround depends on all parties being on the same page.
- WJTA Training and Certification creates a standardized framework bringing safe and effective communication into all phases of hydroblasting and vacuum configuration, planning, and execution. Programs are available for **hydroblasting**, **industrial vacuuming**, and **asset owners**.
- Training curriculum is frequently reviewed and updated to align with WJTA best practices for waterjetting and industrial vacuuming.
- Trainee credentials are transferrable and easily verified or gate checked by facilities or customers.

 - 3-year expiration
 - 80% passing score on multiple choice test

VACUUM

- 19VACFT**
- 3-hour course
 - 3-year expiration
 - 80% passing score on multiple choice test



Field Verification
(Part 2)

- 19HBFV**
- Classroom and hands-on instruction and skills assessment

- 19VACFV**

Training Organization

Company or entity with trainers and sites approved for Field Verification

Sponsor Representative

Main liaison between Training Organization and WJTA

Master Trainer (MT)

Individual approved to deliver Train-the-Trainer courses (in-house or to third parties)

Verified Trainer (VT)

Individual approved to deliver Field Verification (in-house or to third parties)

Verified Training Site (VTS)

Location approved as meeting the equipment and logistical requirements for Field Verification

Foundational Training

Several Ways to Obtain FT

- In-person at Safety Council or ARSC site
- Remote access with live online proctoring

Become Approved to Deliver Field Verification

- Organizations can become approved to deliver FV in-house
- WJTA Corporate Membership Required
- HASC Corporate Membership Required

Source FV Delivery

Outsource Training

- Several OEMs and third parties are approved to deliver Field Verification
- Training organization will handle records submission and compliance with WJTA policies and curriculum

Verified Training Site (VTS) Approval

- Photos document that site meets the equipment requirements to deliver FV
- Approved remotely by a Master Trainer

Train-the-Trainer Course

- Verified Trainer candidate(s) complete FT prerequisite
- FV/Train-the-Trainer courses organized by WJTA or coordinated independently with a Master Trainer

Training Delivered Internally

- Check LINK database to ensure trainees have FT prerequisite
- Complete FV checklist after completing all required instruction and skills verification points
- Submit records to HASC LINK database

Field Verification

Training Delivered by Third Party

- Training organization ensures trainees have FT prerequisite
- Training organization submits records to HASC LINK database

Regular Audit

- Once every three years, an independent Master Trainer will observe VTS and FV delivery
- Confidential feedback will be provided to training organization
